

In the past, we have received numerous requests from parishioners asking if we would offer contributions through credit card, checking or saving accounts.

We are pleased to offer you the option of enrolling in an automatic contribution program that will allow you to do just that. It is called Parish Pay. You can go online to www.ssj.org or www.parishpay.com, a secure website, and in a few minutes be completely enrolled.

Your **monthly** contribution will be debited on the 5th of every month, automatically. You may use your Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover or Debit card. Or, if you prefer, you may use your checking, savings, or brokerage account. There is NO cost to participate in the program.

At the same time as designating your monthly contribution, you can also designate contributions to Easter, Christmas and our new SSJ building fund. Easter will be debited in April or May (or whichever month Easter falls) and Christmas will be debited in December.

Frequently Asked Questions

“What is Automated Giving?”

This is an alternate means of support for Sts. Simon & Jude instead of using envelopes. In lieu of weekly collections, the ParishPay program will collect monthly contributions from your checking, savings, or credit card accounts.

“What are the benefits to me?”

- Allows you to plan your giving, in the same way you budget your other financial commitments.
- You no longer have to be concerned about catching-up missed weekly donations when you miss a Mass because you are out of town, on vacation, ill, etc.

"What about the weekly envelopes that I use"?

Initially you will still receive your monthly envelopes as there will be other special collections that will not be covered under ParishPay at this time.

"I feel uncomfortable not having something to physically drop into the collection basket. What should I do?"

Special donation slips will be available for those enrolled in the automated giving program to be dropped into the collection basket, should you wish.

What if I don't have access to a computer or the internet?

No problem! Enrollment envelopes are available in the back of the church and in the Parish Office. Complete the form and then drop it in the collection, mail it to us or bring it to the office. We will enroll for you.
