

# Music Expectancies (5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> Grades)

- Students will learn to play musical instruments:
  - 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grades – soprano recorder
  - 7<sup>th</sup> grade – hand chimes
- Students will sing liturgical songs and will learn to distinguish the different parts of a mass where a song would be appropriate.
- Students will be introduced to different genres of music from 14<sup>th</sup> century Chant to the 20<sup>th</sup> century Popular music. They will also be introduced to some non-western music from around the world
- Students will learn general music history
- Students will be able to identify some of the different Western instruments.
- Students will learn to read and write music: pitch and rhythm
- Students will have musical performance experiences with their instruments and voices
- Students will be able to learn songs from standard notation
- Students will have experiences in performing in ensembles
- Students will develop the ability to perform in two or more parts
- Students will develop the ability to maintain poise under pressure
