Dear Parents,

Students will have an opportunity to attend **summer sessions** at Sts. Simon & Jude School again this year. If there is enough interest, classes will be offered in math and reading/language arts for students entering grades two through eight. The summer school sessions will be held four days a week, Monday through Thursday, from June 22 through July 16. There will be two classes each day. The first class will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 9:45 a.m. The second class will begin at 10:00 a.m. and end at 11:45 a.m. Students may attend one or both classes. There is a separate fee for each class. See the attached registration form for details. Please fill out one form for each student you are registering. The tuition fee has remained unchanged since the summer of 2007 and includes books, the Family Library Pass, supplies and insurance. The **registration deadline is Wednesday, May 27**, but the tuition payment is not due until June 22. You may call the library at 714-962-1602 or e-mail [sdaniels@ssj.org](mailto:sdaniels@ssj.org) with any questions. Please register early as each class is strictly limited to fifteen students.

Any students entering grades five through eight who master at least 20 objectives during the summer session will have their math goals reduced by five objectives per quarter for the 2009-2010 school year. Students entering grades two through four mastering Accelerated Math (STAR Math) objectives during summer school will have the opportunity to “test out” of these objectives in the fall and have them applied to their math record for the first quarter of the school year. Points earned on STAR Reading quizzes taken during the summer session will be distributed to the student reading records over the four quarters of the 2009-2010 school year.

Please note: This year the 4<sup>th</sup> of July falls on a Saturday. We will be taking Monday, July 6 off for a long holiday weekend. School will be in session July 7, 8 and 9 this third week.

We look forward to another successful summer of learning.
