# YEAR 1 CONFIRMATION

## 2023/2024 OVERVIEW

Welcome to the Confirmation Journey at Saints Simon & Jude Catholic Church! The Sacrament of Confirmation consists of two years of preparation for those in 9th, 10th, or 11th grade. As the junior and senior years of High School can be demanding, it is recommended that Candidates begin their preparation in 9th grade. This also helps foster community and faith alongside their peers. However, the two year journey can begin anytime up until the senior year of High School. Preparation includes meetings, special events for candidates/sponsor/parents, a Year 1 day retreat, a Year 2 weekend retreat, and service in the community. But most importantly, this is an opportunity for high school students to learn more about their Catholic faith, experience their faith, and discover why being fully initiated into the Catholic Church is an incredible gift.

# **MEETINGS**

Year 1 meets in the Youth Room on alternating Sundays beginning in October and ending in May. We have two class times to choose from: 10:00am - 11:15am or 3:45pm - 5:00pm.

Candidates must sign up for their preferred meeting time at registration but will be able to switch to a different meeting if needed throughout the year.

We begin with a large group gathering and then break up into small groups led by our high school Peer Ministers and adult small group leaders. Meetings will end with the celebration of Mass at 11:15am and 5:00pm. Candidates are not required to attend this Mass but we encourage attendance alongside their family. This can be a journey of faith for the whole family!

This meeting is for the parent/guardian(s) and child who will be beginning the Confirmation Journey. It will provide you with all the information that you need to know about Confirmation preparation at Saints Simon & Jude.



# YOUTH MINISTRY

#### SAINTS SIMON & JUDE YOUTH

Saints Simon & Jude Youth is a welcoming and inclusive space for teens to pray, serve, and grow in relationship with Christ. We strive to provide young people and their parents encounters to grow closer to God and each other. All high school students are welcome. You do not need to be a part of the Confirmation Journey in order to attend and there are no "requirements" for Confirmation Candidates to attend either. However, all of our Youth Ministry gatherings are a great accompaniment to the Confirmation journey.



#### **BIBLE STUDY**

**Every Wednesday from 7:00pm to 8:30pm** we have a Bible Study in the Youth Room for all high school students. This is the perfect opportunity to pause in the middle of the week, hang out with friends, eat snacks, play games, and discuss Sunday's Gospel. It offers everyone a safe and friendly environment to grow in faith and fellowship. You don't need to be in Confirmation or a Peer Minister to attend. All are welcome.

#### SOCIALS

Every month we will have at least one high school social event. These will be held here at the church or at an off-site venue. This is an opportunity for all high school students to gather in community, share a meal together, and have some fun. These evenings will include dinner & games here at the church, beach bonfires, bowling, or a movie night, for example. Our first three socials will be – off-site event 10/15 - Friendsgiving 11/12 - Christmas Party 12/17

#### **XLTS**

XLT stands for Exalt, which is a night of prayer for our entire community. We will have contemporary praise & worship, a message from a guest speaker, Confession, and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

# WHAT IF YOU MISS A MEETING?

Confirmation Meetings foster community, encourage experiential faith, and promote discussions on a variety of topics & issues. At the end of Year 2, our Pastor must be able to present Candidates to the Bishop at the Confirmation Mass by saying, "The candidates presented are prepared and ready to receive the fullness of Christian Initiation in the Sacrament of Confirmation." To be "prepared and ready" refers to attending and participating in the meetings along with regular Mass attendance. Attendance will be taken for each class and revisited throughout the journey to ensure we are able to present them to the Bishop fully prepared. However, we know that schedules, sickness, and family events can sometimes be hard to navigate.

#### HOW TO "MAKE UP" MISSED CONFIRMATION MEETINGS



The Confirmation classes are standalone. There is no "make-up" class that fully revisits the topic. However, if a class is missed through illness or because of an important family event, we ask that the candidate attend another Youth Ministry event such as Bible Study, XLT, or social event and complete an at-home reflection. These opportunities for "make-ups" should only be used if necessary. Candidates are of course invited to Youth Ministry events in addition to class attendance. # SPONSORS, SAINTS & SERVICE

#### YEAR 1 & YEAR 2

There are a few additional components to the Confirmation journey that Year 1 Candidates can start to think and pray about. Each Candidate must pick a Sponsor, a Saint, and an area of discipleship (service.) In the past, these were normally focused on in the second year of the Confirmation Journey, but we want to encourage all candidates to consider making a decision on these aspects of Confirmation ASAP.



#### SPONSORS

Confirmation Sponsors will help the Confirmandi to fulfill their baptismal promise, faithfully under the influence of the Holy Spirit. It is recommended that the the sponsor be the candidate's godparent (if still actively involved in the Confirmandi's life.) However, a sponsor can be any faithful, confirmed Catholic who is over 16 years of age and not a parent/guardian. Sponsors should be a mentor, guide, an example in the life of the Candidate.

#### SAINTS

We see in scripture that God changed the names of people to signify their role had been changed and that they were becoming, in a sense, a new person. Choosing a Saint is an essential part of Confirmation and it is an acknowledgement that the Holy Spirit will change you through the grace of this Sacrament. In Year 1 each candidate is invited to write a reflection on the Saint they have chosen for their Confirmation. More info soon!

## SERVICE / DISCIPLESHIP

People often take part in "Service Projects" as a way of helping others. However, the word "project" implies an act that has a beginning and an end. That is why we prefer to call this "Discipleship". Each candidate is invited to become involved in an area of Discipleship as part of their Confirmation journey. This should be something that serves our parish or local community. More information will be provided at a later date, but consider serving in some area soon!
